

2. Registered colonies by state agency "Agricultural data centre"




Apiary sizes (grouped by numbers of colonies per apiary, % of all):



## Honey production from bee colony







## Honey distribution

Direct sales (to end consumer) : 68 %  
Sales to retailers : 8 %  
Wholesales (bulk, to packer) : 20 %  
Food industry (bakeries etc.) : 4 %





## Honey prices (average)


Direct sales (to end consumer) :	4,50 EUR / kg
Sales to retailers :	4,00 EUR / kg






## Growth in numbers of members in Beekeepers association

## Organic bee farms:


