




Working in "Binævnet"

- New law on beekeeping
 - took force on 1 January 2007
 - Binævnet was formed as a result of the new law



"Binævnet"





The purpose of "Binævnet"

§2. Binævnet have to advise the Minister for Food, Agriculture and Fisheries and the Director of Plant Directorate on matters concerning the Act on beekeeping and regulations established there under. The Board has also been established to advise on the implementation of EU rules and other international obligations. Additionally, Binævnet advise the Minister on other issues about beekeeping and its development opportunities.

1. Adequate pollination

- The Ministry will support the beekeepers' initiatives practically and administratively, in their efforts to provide healthy colonies and a distribution that will provide an adequate bee pollination of cultivated crops and wild plants in all parts of the country.



2. Securing the business environment

- The Ministry will support the beekeepers' initiatives practically and administratively in the development of good business conditions to ensure a sufficient number of beekeepers with a sufficient number of healthy colonies of bees in all parts of the country.



3. Research, development and international cooperation

- The Ministry will support initiatives, practical and administrative related to research, development and international cooperation, which helps to obtain and spread new knowledge about pests, genetics and methodology for beekeeping, to ensure sufficient pollination and good business conditions.


The Beekeeping Legislation

 - Approved mating areas for honey bees
 - pest of honey bees and bumble bees
 - relocation of honey bees etc.
- circular letters
 - Guidelines for the Bee inspector







The beekeepers

- Commercial Beekeepers
 - Breeding with their own queen lines
 - Sale of queens for hobby and professional beekeepers
 - Great experience
 - Well documented breeding parameters
 - Own mating stations
 - Pool mating of production queens
 - Import of breeding queens






- Hobby Beekeepers
 - less experience
 - Mating in own apiary
 - Pure breeding
 - Depending on the open mating stations



Status of the Danish breeding work



- High quality
 - Peaceful bees
 - Satisfactory honey yield
 - Resistant to diseases
 - Well organized
 - Well documented
 - High level of knowledge / experience
 - Open mating stations
 - accessible to all beekeepers
